

SEP: Special Enrollment

You can enroll in the Massachusetts Health Connector during a special enrollment period (SEP) if you experience a qualifying life event like job loss or a change in household size, or if you're newly eligible for a ConnectorCare plan. To apply, visit the MAHealthConnector.org website to complete your application, as you have a limited time to enroll after a qualifying event occurs.

What is a Special Enrollment Period (SEP)?

An SEP allows you to enroll in health insurance outside of the main open enrollment period.

What qualifies for an SEP?

- **Qualifying Life Events:**

You may be eligible for an SEP if you have a qualifying life event such as:

- *Getting married or divorced*
- *Having a child or losing a dependent*
- *Losing your job or losing other minimum essential coverage*
- *Moving to Massachusetts or moving within the state*

- **ConnectorCare Eligibility:**

You automatically qualify for an SEP if you are newly determined to be eligible for a ConnectorCare plan through the Health Connector.

- **Other Situations:**

You can also enroll any time of year if you qualify for MassHealth, are applying for dental insurance, or are a member of a federally recognized tribe.
